Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics, students must maintain passing grades in all classes in which the student is enrolled in, have at least a 2.0 grade point average, with no more than one “D” and no “F”s”.

Students who, upon having their work checked on a cumulative basis at the end of each three-week period, show that they are not meeting the eligibility criteria established in policy, will be removed from any athletic teams or extracurricular activities, and will remain ineligible to participate in either practice or competition, for a one-week period. These students’ grades will then be reviewed on a weekly basis. Students who subsequently meet the eligibility criteria will be reinstated to the teams or extracurricular activities unless ineligible for some other reason other than academic performance.



Supervision

Coaches take responsibility for supervising student-athletes. Athletes are supervised at all times, before and after practices, during practice, at games, and until athletes leave campus.

Parents are responsible for picking up student-athletes. The first time the athlete is picked up 20 minutes late or more, the coach will talk to the parent; the second time, the coach will warn the parent that the athlete may be suspended from the team; the third time, the athlete may be suspended from the team.
